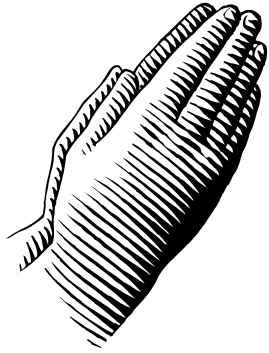

Looking Forward

Taking care of those in need will be our emphasis through the fall and winter months. Last Sunday we took a look at the first chapter of the Book of James. James 1:22 states: "But be doers of the word, and not merely hearers who deceive themselves." What does it mean to be doers of the word? First and foremost we are to bring others to Christ, and live by his teachings. And there is the challenge; to live by His teachings. Jesus talked of, and worked to, alleviate the suffering of people. In this difficult economy we find that there is need all around us. Even those of us who have steady employment have had to make adjustments. Imagine what it is like for the thousands in our area who no longer have employment. This was brought home to me recently in a meeting with area pastors, and representatives of the Christian Care Center. We collect food for the Christian Care Center as an ongoing ministry of the church, but seem to have slacked off in the past few months. Their representatives informed us during the meeting that though food donations have been steady (from other groups), the demand has increased dramatically. The CCC had to purchase more food this year than they have purchased in all of their prior years combined. All because of the increase in need.

Also, recently I have been in contact with individuals who are out of work, and unable to support their families. I mentioned this Sunday, and was overwhelmed with the compassionate response by our members. We have assisted one family with rent, back to school supplies, and one of our families is purchasing a back to school outfit for a child whose family cannot do so. We all have the desire to help others, and that is being "doers" of the word. I thank God for your compassionate hearts. There is much left to do, and we will continue. Clothes for the needy!
