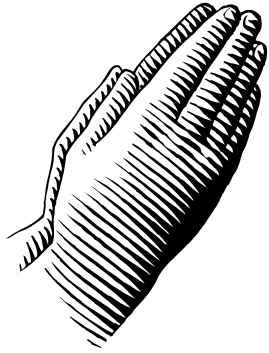

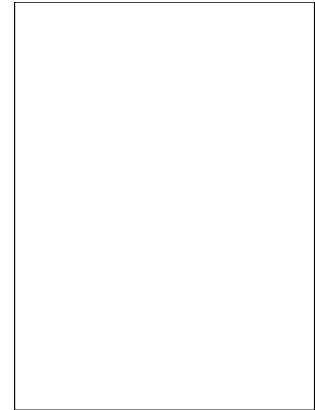

We continue to have a stream of guests with us on Sundays, and we Welcome them all.
